Dear Parents / Carers,

During this term **Year 3** have been learning about the Stone Age to the Iron Age. To support this, we are visiting **Brackenhurst Environmental Education Centre**. The children will travel back in time to learn in a fun and engaging way, recognising changes in Britain from the present day back to the Stone, Bronze and Iron Ages. They will learn what man needed to survive.

The visit for **Blackbirds** class will take place on **Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> November 2024**. The children will need to come to school for the normal start of the day and we will aim to return to school by the end of the school day depending on traffic (you will be informed by text if there are any delays).

We are pleased to be able to subsidise the cost of the visit in our efforts to provide curriculum enrichment opportunities for every child in school, as a result the cost of this visit will be **£21.50** per child. There is a further subsidy for those children in receipt of Pupil Premium funding. Please make payment and give consent for your child to attend on the **School Gateway App** by Friday 1<sup>st</sup> November 2024.

On the day of the visit children will need to wear casual, comfortable clothing which is warm and suitable for all weather conditions. Please ensure they have a waterproof coat, suitable footwear and a packed lunch in a small bag which is easily carried. A packed lunch can be provided by the school kitchen should you wish to order one for the cost of £3.25 (or free school meals apply).
