Dear Parents/Carers

We have arranged an exciting trip for Year 6 to go to The National Holocaust Centre. Our visit to the Holocaust Museum aims to develop the children's understanding of how the War affected the lives of children during WW II and how people's lives were changed by the events of WW II.

The trip will take place on **Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> November 2025**. The children will need to come to school for the normal start of the day and we will aim to return to school by **4pm** depending on traffic (you will be informed by text if there are any delays). All children will need to be collected from school.

While at the museum we will be learning more about the lives of the people who lived through World War II and taking part in a workshop related to our History and English Units. The children will also get to hear the story of a holocaust survivor.

We are pleased to be able to subsidise the cost of the visit in our efforts to provide curriculum enrichment opportunities for every child in school, as a result the cost of this visit will be **£17.00** per child. There is a further subsidy for those children in receipt of Pupil Premium funding. Please make payment and give consent for your child to attend on the **School Gateway App** by **Friday 31<sup>st</sup> October 2025**.

On the day of the visit children will need to wear school uniform, have a coat, suitable footwear and a packed lunch in a small bag which is easily carried. A packed lunch can be provided by the school kitchen should you wish to order one for the cost of £3.25 (or free school meals apply). Please advise the school office if you would like to order a school packed lunch.
