Dear Parents/Carers

During this term, Year 3 have been learning about how Britain changed between the Stone Age, Bronze Age and the Iron Age. To support this work, we will be going on an exciting trip to Creswell Crags in Nottinghamshire. The children will take part in three activities over the site: Survival Skills, Life in the Ice Age Cave Tour and an Art of the Ancients workshop.

The trip will take place on **Monday 8th December 2025**. The children will need to come to school for the normal start of the day and we will aim to return to school by 3.15pm, if there are any delays due to traffic, you will be informed by text message on the day.

Due to the nature of the site and the activities the children will be doing, we ask that they come to school in a school jumper / cardigan, jogging bottoms that are warm and can potentially get muddy, practical footwear, waterproof coat and hat. The school kitchen can provide a packed lunch for your child if required for the cost of **£3.25** or Free School Meals apply. Please advise the school office by **Friday 5th December 2025** if you would like to order a school packed lunch.

We appreciate that there have already been two visits for which payment has been in close succession, therefore as a result, there will be no cost for this visit. We just require you to give consent on the Gateway App.

Due to the nature of the Creswell Crags site, it would be beneficial if we could take a small number of adult helpers with us on the trip to assist with moving the children from area to area. Please advise your child's class teacher or the school office if you are able to join us.
