Dear Parents / Carers,

During this term, Year 5 have been learning about The Industrial Revolution in History. To support this work we will be going on an exciting trip to **The Nottingham Industrial Museum**, in Wollaton. The museum has five galleries of exhibits to celebrate the history of industry in Nottingham and the local area. This will be an exciting opportunity for the children to see the steam engines built in Sandiacre and various technology invented during the revolution.

The trip will take place on **Thursday 15th January 2026**.

The visit will take place in the morning and the children will return to school in time to access their usual school meal choice. The children will need to wear **school uniform**, and bring a **coat**.

We are pleased to be able to subsidise the cost of the visit in our efforts to provide curriculum enrichment opportunities for every child in school, as a result the cost of this visit will be **£6.00** per child. There is a further subsidy for those children in receipt of Pupil Premium funding. Please make payment and give consent for your child to attend on the **School Gateway App** by **Friday 9th January 2026**.
