Dear Parents / Carers,

Next half term, Year 4 will be learning about solids, liquids and gasses. To support this, we are visiting **Magna Science and Technology Museum**. The children will take part in a range of exciting activities and have the opportunity to explore the museum.

The visit will take place on **Thursday 5th March 2026**. The children will need to come to school for the normal start of the day and we will aim to return to school by the end of the school day depending on traffic (you will be informed by text if there are any delays).

We are pleased to be able to subsidise the cost of the visit in our efforts to provide curriculum enrichment opportunities for every child in school, as a result the cost of this visit will be **£18.00** per child. A packed lunch can be provided by the school kitchen should you wish to order one for the cost of £3.25 (or free school meals apply), please let the office know.
