Dear Parents/Carers

During the autumn term, Year 5 will be covering the topic of Vikings in History. To support this work, we will be going on an exciting trip to The Jorvik Viking centre in York. They will have the chance to explore its museum and take part in workshops and tours about battle tactics, Viking sagas and discovering Viking artefacts.

The trip will take place on **Tuesday 20th October 2026**. The children will need to come to school for 7.30am and we will return to school by 4.45pm. We will message if there are any delays due to traffic.

We are pleased to be able to subsidise the cost of the visit in our efforts to provide curriculum enrichment opportunities for every child in school, as a result the cost of this visit will be **£28.00** per child. There is a further subsidy for those children in receipt of Pupil Premium funding. Please make payment and give consent for your child to attend on the **School Gateway App** by Monday 19th October 2026.

On the day of the visit children will need to wear school uniform, have a coat, suitable footwear and a packed lunch in a small bag which is easily carried. A packed lunch can be provided by the school kitchen should you wish to order one for the cost of £3.25 (or free school meals apply). Please advise the office if you would like to order a school packed lunch for your child.

We are also looking for some parent helpers to join us on this visit, so if you are willing, please let us know.
