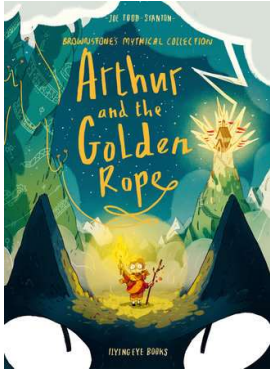
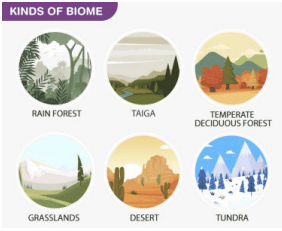
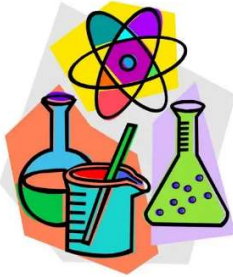


YEAR 4 CURRICULUM LETTER – Wrens & Robins –

AUTUMN TERM 1

	Subject	What are we learning this half term?
Maths		This term we will be focusing on place value, including 1s, 10s, 100s and 1000s. Children will be learning how to flexibly represent and partition numbers to 1000 (including the use of number lines and manipulatives), as well as how to indicate 1, 10, 100 or 1000 more or less than any given number. Please help your child with their number fluency at home using Sumdog! Ask your child's class teacher for a reminder of your child's login if needed.
English		In English, we will be reading Arthur and the Golden Rope by Joe-Todd Stanton. Within this unit, we will be aiming to write a resolution to the journey Arthur goes on. There will be a feature on using powerful vocabulary and using inverted commas accurately.
Curriculum		This term in Geography, we will be answering our 'Big Question' – 'What are biomes and why are they important?' and in History our 'Big Question' will be 'What is the legacy of the Roman Occupation of Great Britain?' If you have any significant family links to either our History or Geography learning, we would love to hear about them!
Science		In Science, our 'Big Question' will be 'What is electricity and why is it so important to our lives?' During this topic, we will be building simple circuits and learning how to draw them. We will also investigate which materials are conductors and which are insulators.
