<p><u>A.</u> <u>Geographical Skills and fieldwork</u></p>	<p>1. ALL: I can communicate my findings using the appropriate vocabulary MOST: I can investigate and use the correct vocabulary to share findings SOME: I can investigate and use the correct vocabulary to share findings and explanations</p> <p>2. ALL: I can begin to investigate and use the correct vocabulary to share findings</p> <p>3. ALL: I can use North, East, South and West and 4 digit grid references MOST: I can use the 8 points of the compass and 4 and 6 digit grid references SOME: I can use the 8 points of the compass and 4 and 6 digit grid references, symbols and keys</p>

ALL: I can describe the physical and human characteristics of a location MOST: I can recognise how physical and human characteristics can affect the lives and activities of people living there SOME: I can recognise how physical and human characteristics can affect the lives and activities of people living there by using a case study</p>
<p><u>C.</u> <u>Locational Knowledge</u></p>	<p>1. ALL: I can name many of the world’s major rivers MOST: I can name and locate many of the world’s major rivers on maps SOME: I can name and locate many of the world’s major rivers on maps and know where the mouth is</p> <p>2. ALL: I can name the world’s most famous mountains MOST: I can name and locate many of the world’s most famous mountain regions on maps</p>

	<p>SOME: I can name and locate many of the world's most famous mountain regions on maps and identify the tallest peaks</p> <p>3. ALL: I can locate the USA and Canada on a world map and atlas</p> <p>4. ALL: I can locate and name the main countries in South America on a world map and atlas</p> <p>5. ALL: I can name 4 counties of the UK and locate one city within each county MOST: I can name and locate counties and cities in the UK SOME: I can name, locate and describe counties and cities in the UK</p> <p>6. ALL: I can identify examples of topographical features MOST: I can identify key topographical features and land use patterns SOME: I can identify key topographical features and land use patterns and explain their impact on the people living there</p>
