Dear Parents / Carers

We are pleased to inform you we have new staff members joining us in January. Mrs Russell will be joining us as SEN teacher for our Ducklings class, Mr Roulstone will be PE leader and Ms Wilson will be responsible for Safeguarding and Attendance.

In addition to this, Mrs Wass has been away from school due to illness for the past few weeks. During this time I have been spending a considerable amount of time at Cloudside to support the team and ensure the impact of her absence has been minimised.
