Queen's Jubilee celebration

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are all getting excited for our Queen's Platinum Jubilee Celebrations on Thursday 26th May. You may have noticed some changes to the outside areas in preparation for the plans we have for the day. I wanted to send a reminder about a few key facts about the celebration.

On Thursday, the children can wear non-school uniform and we ask that they come into school wearing something that is red, white and or/ blue. We will be taking a photo using a drone to capture the children forming a 70 in these colours. For the coronation and afternoon activities, the children can get changed into more formal (party) clothing if they wish. We will make sure that there is time for the children to get changed after lunch.

We will be mixing the classes up so that children across the school are in groups and rotate around a range of activities during the morning including sports, art, gardening and baking.

We would love for families to be involved in our celebrations and we will be hosting an afternoon tea at 2:30pm. If you can join us, please come to the office at 2:30pm and we will sign you in before going to the field.

If the weather is nice, we will be enjoying the afternoon tea on the field. If you have a picnic blanket, please bring it along and we will enjoy some sandwiches, cakes and tea on the grass. If the weather is against us we will still go ahead with our plans of afternoon tea indoors, please still come along. As it is the last day of the half term, the children will return to their classrooms at 3:00pm to collect their belongings. Children will be collected from their classroom door like normal. If you do attend the afternoon tea, you may take your child home once they have gathered their belongings.

During the afternoon Mrs Wheatley will be holding a used book sale where books can be bought, prices up to 50p per book. We hope that you will find something that your child would love to read at home.

It is going to be a fun filled day that the children will remember for years to come.
