To build upon the Year 4 learning about local habitats and food chains in Science this term, we are excited to announce a school trip on **Thursday 20th June 2024** to Conkers. They will take part in a range of exciting activities linked to the food chains within different habitats, the understanding of predators and prey as well as looking at what naturally breaks down to make the perfect compost.

The children will need to come to school for the normal start of the day and we will return to school by the close of the school day. We will message if there are any delays due to traffic.

We are pleased to be able to subsidise the cost of the visit in our efforts to provide curriculum enrichment opportunities for every child in school, as a result the cost of this visit will be **£12.00** per child. There is a further subsidy for those children in receipt of Pupil Premium funding. Please make payment and give consent for your child to attend on the **School Gateway App** by Friday 14th June 2024.

On the day of the visit children will need to wear school uniform, have a coat, suitable footwear and a packed lunch in a small bag which is easily carried. A packed lunch can be provided by the school kitchen should you wish to order one for the cost of £3.25 (or free school meals apply).
